DAY 1 (Saturday) (SYDNEY — TAMWORTH)
8.00 a.m. Depart Sydney from Belmore Park, Eddy Avenue.
11.00 a.m. Newcastle Passengers embark at Taxi Co-Op. Hamilton, travel the New England Highway through Singleton, Scone, Murrumbidgee, Quirindi to arrive Tamworth for overnight stay.

DAY 2 (Sunday) (TAMWORTH — DALBY)
7.00 a.m. Depart Tamworth after Tamworth Passengers embark at Hannaford's Depot, 11 Stewart Avenue, West Tamworth, travel via Armidale, Glen Innes to Tentfield for Luncheon stop. Proceed via Stanthorpe, Warwick to Toowoomba — Garden City of the Darling Downs. Note: Brisbane Passengers depart Greyhound Terminal, 79 Melbourne Street South Brisbane at 11.30 a.m. and travel with Greyhound Coach arriving Toowoomba at 1.55 p.m. joining Hannaford's at Greyhound Terminal Toowoomba at 4.00 p.m. Proceed to Dalby for overnight stay.

DAY 3 (Monday) (DALBY — AUGATHIELLA)
Travel takes you through Roma, renowned for its Oil and Gas Fields, westwards through Mitchell to Charleville. It was here that Ross and Keith Smith landed in 1919 on the first Flight from England to Australia. Proceed to Augathella for overnight stay.

DAY 4 (Tuesday) (AUGATHIELLA — WINTON)
Depart Augathella travelling through Tambo, Blackall to Barcardine visiting the Tree of Knowledge — first meeting place of The Australian Labour Party. Proceed to Longreach situated on The Tropic of Capricorn. Qantas had its Headquarters here in the early days of the Company. Travel to Winton for overnight stay.

After a visit to Banjo Paterson Memorial Olympic Pool, we travel The Western Queensland Beef Road, passing Combs Water Hole — setting of famous "Waltzing Matilda", outback towns of Kynna and McKinlay, only Concurry once a flourishing Copper Mining Town, Ghost Town of Mary Kathleen once Uranium Mining. Proceed to Mount Isa for overnight stay.

DAY 6 (Thursday) (MOUNT ISA — FREWENA)
Morning Tour of Mount Isa. Lead, Copper, Silver and Zinc Mines. Free time for Shopping, Lunch and Swim at Lake Moondarra Mount Isa Water Supply. Proceed via The Barkley Highway through Camowal crossing the Queensland - Northern Territory border to Frewena for overnight stay.

DAY 7 (Friday) (FREWENA — MATARANKA)
Travelling across Worlds largest Cattle Stations, we join the Stuart Highway at The John Flynn Memorial (Three Ways) travel via Banksia Banksia, Renner Springs, Elliott, Larriham Bulk Rail Head to Mataranka Homestead for overnight stay.
Relax and enjoy a Swim in the Thermal Springs.

DAY 8 (Saturday) (MATARANKA — DARWIN)
Proceed to Katherine, Pine Creek, visiting Adelaide River, War Cemetery, Giant Ant Hills and many other points to arrive Darwin for overnight stay.

DAY 9 (Sunday) (DARWIN — DARWIN)
Morning Tour of Darwin visiting New Government Buildings, Chinese Temple, Fannie Bay Golf, East Point, Botanical Gardens and many more points of interest. Full Day at Leisure. (Lunch all Passengers by own arrangement)


DAY 21 (Friday) (ADELAIDE — HAY)


DAY 23 (Sunday) (MITTAGONG — TAMWORTH)
